





Discover Anadia: Land of Wines, Thermal Waters and Passion

In the heart of Bairrada, between Aveiro and Coimbra, Anadia is a destination that combines authenticity, bold flavors, and experiences to be enjoyed without haste. A land of excellence in wines and sparkling wines, it invites you to discover the cellars, museums, and vineyard landscapes that define the region's identity.

Gastronomy is one of its greatest assets, with the 'Bairrada Roast Suckling Pig' as the king of the table, paired with local sparkling wines and traditional pastries that surprise with every bite. For moments of tranquility, the Curia Thermal Spa offers well-being in an elegant setting, surrounded by gardens and historical heritage inspired by the Roaring Twenties.

Anadia is also about nature, culture, and movement. Viewpoints, parks, museums, and world-class sports facilities – such as the National Velodrome – make the municipality a dynamic space where leisure, adventure, and tradition coexist in perfect harmony.

Fall in love with Curia and its Thermal Waters

Travel back to the Belle Époque and let yourself be enchanted by the charm of Curia. Stroll down the 'Avenida dos Plátanos' to the Thermal Park, a romantic space of gardens, centuries-old avenues, a lake, and historic buildings that evoke the Roaring Twenties.

After your stroll, enjoy the renowned thermal waters, available by appointment at the Hotel das Termas da Curia.

Visit the Curia Palace Hotel, designed by architect Norte Júnior and opened in 1926, a symbol of the era's glamour and cosmopolitanism. The hotel and its surroundings have been classified as a Site of Public Interest since 2013. Discover the former Railway Station, designed by architect Cottinelli Telmo and featuring tile panels by Jorge Barradas—now transformed into Espaço Bairrada, a venue dedicated to regional products and wine tourism experiences.

Anadia in Motion

Anadia is a sports center of excellence. The day begins at the **Two-Wheel Museum (M2R)**, located at the High Performance Center (HPC) - National Velodrome, in Sangalhos. Opened in 2009, the HPC is unique in Portugal and hosts national and international training and competitions.

The M2R collection consists of cycling and motorcycling pieces from the 19th century to the present day, showcasing

the industry's strong connection to the region. The guided tour is engaging and filled with stories of triumph and sporting memories.

Still in Sangalhos, visit the EcoPark, featuring the Viewpoint and the monument in honor of Alves Barbosa.
